You can form the past simple form of regular verbs by **adding -ed**. However, **there are lots of irregular verbs** that don't follow this rule.

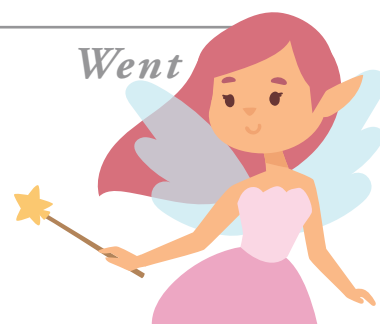

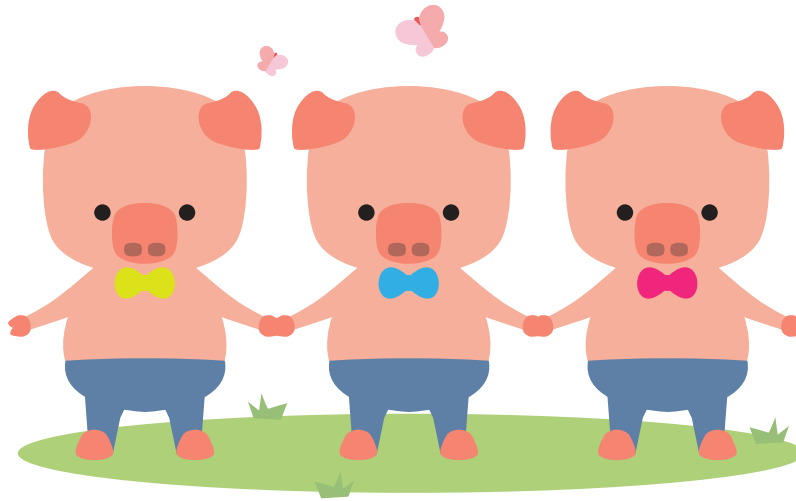
