Why did he come to the cinema?

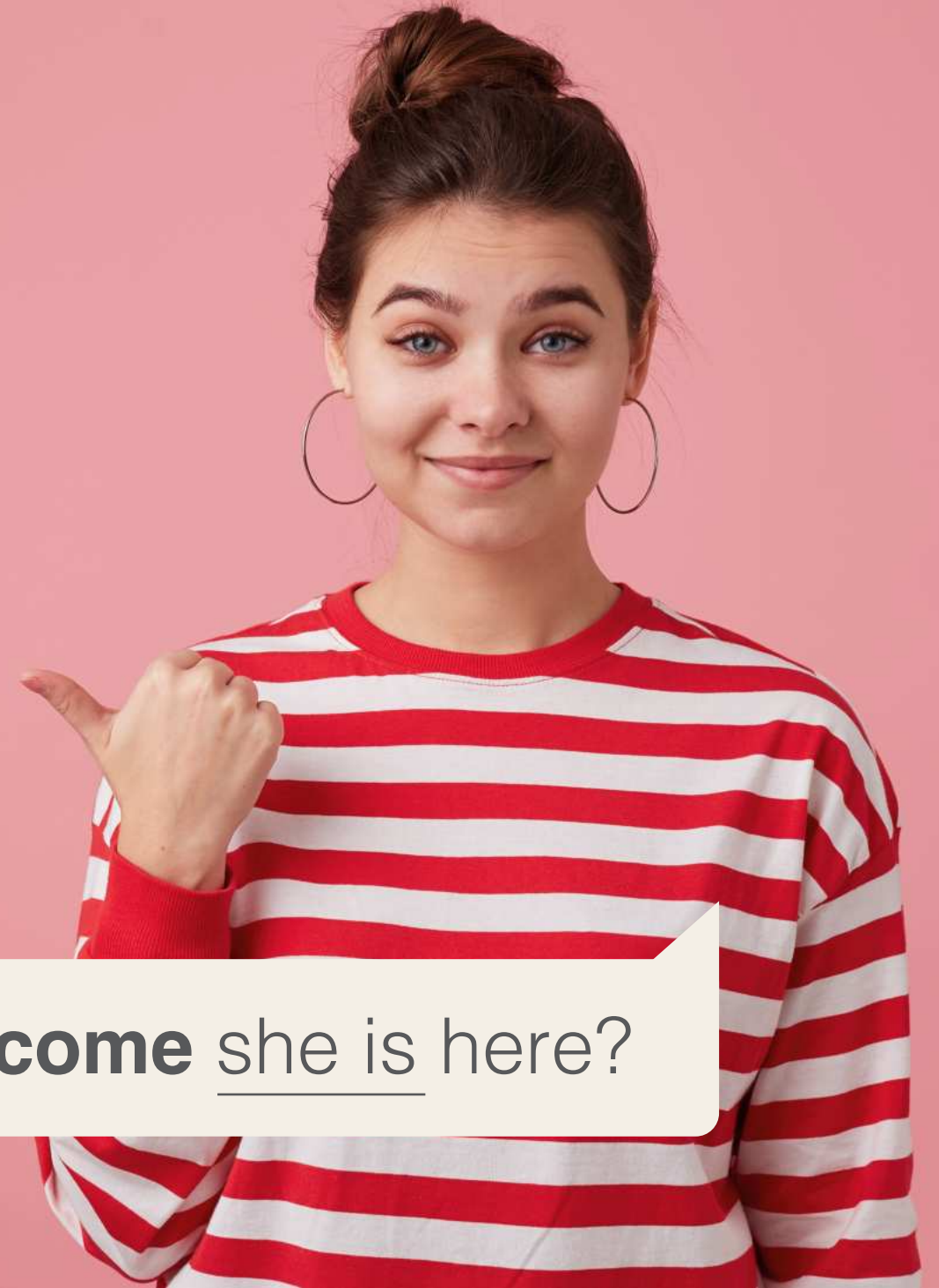


How come he came to the cinema?

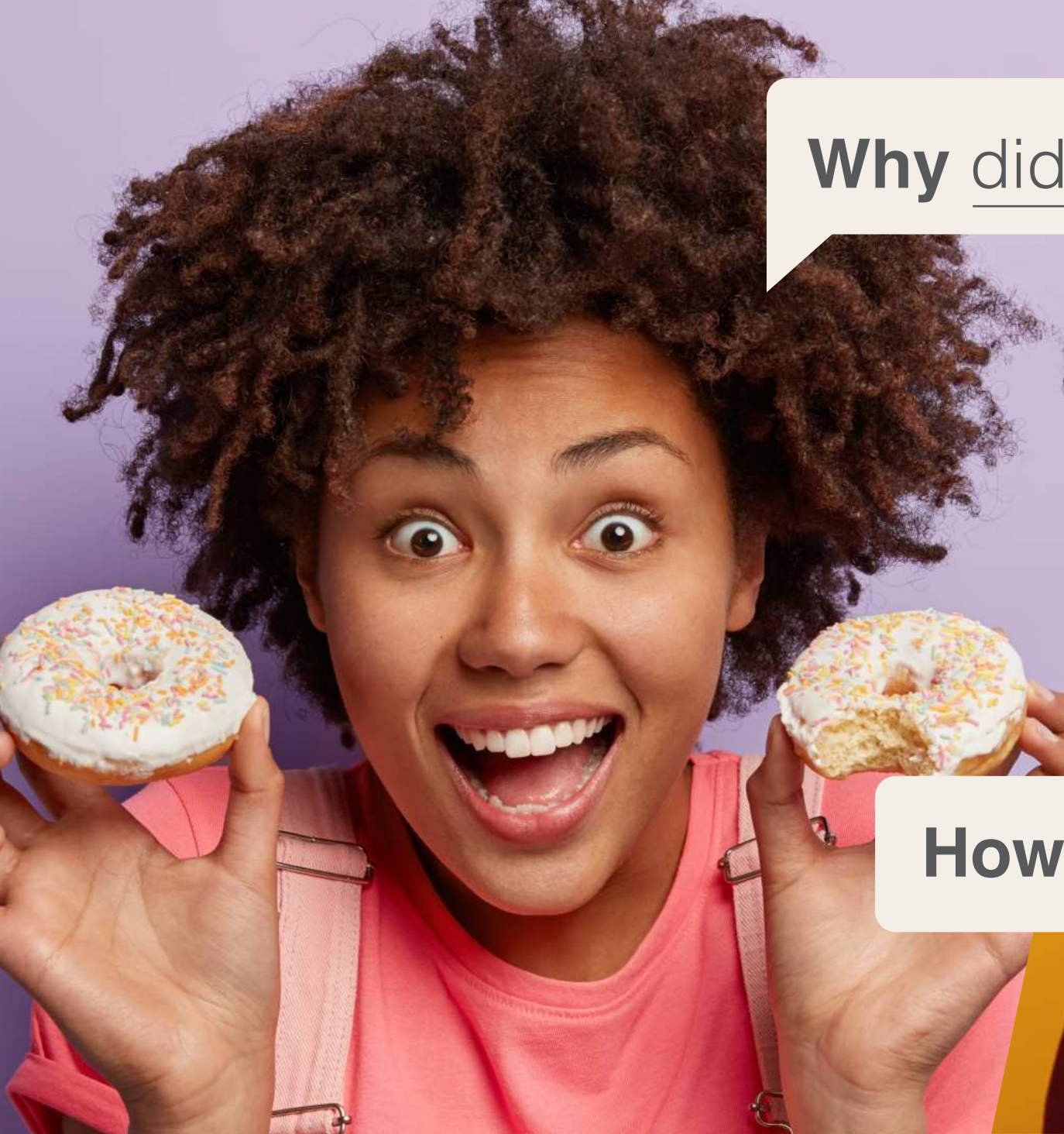




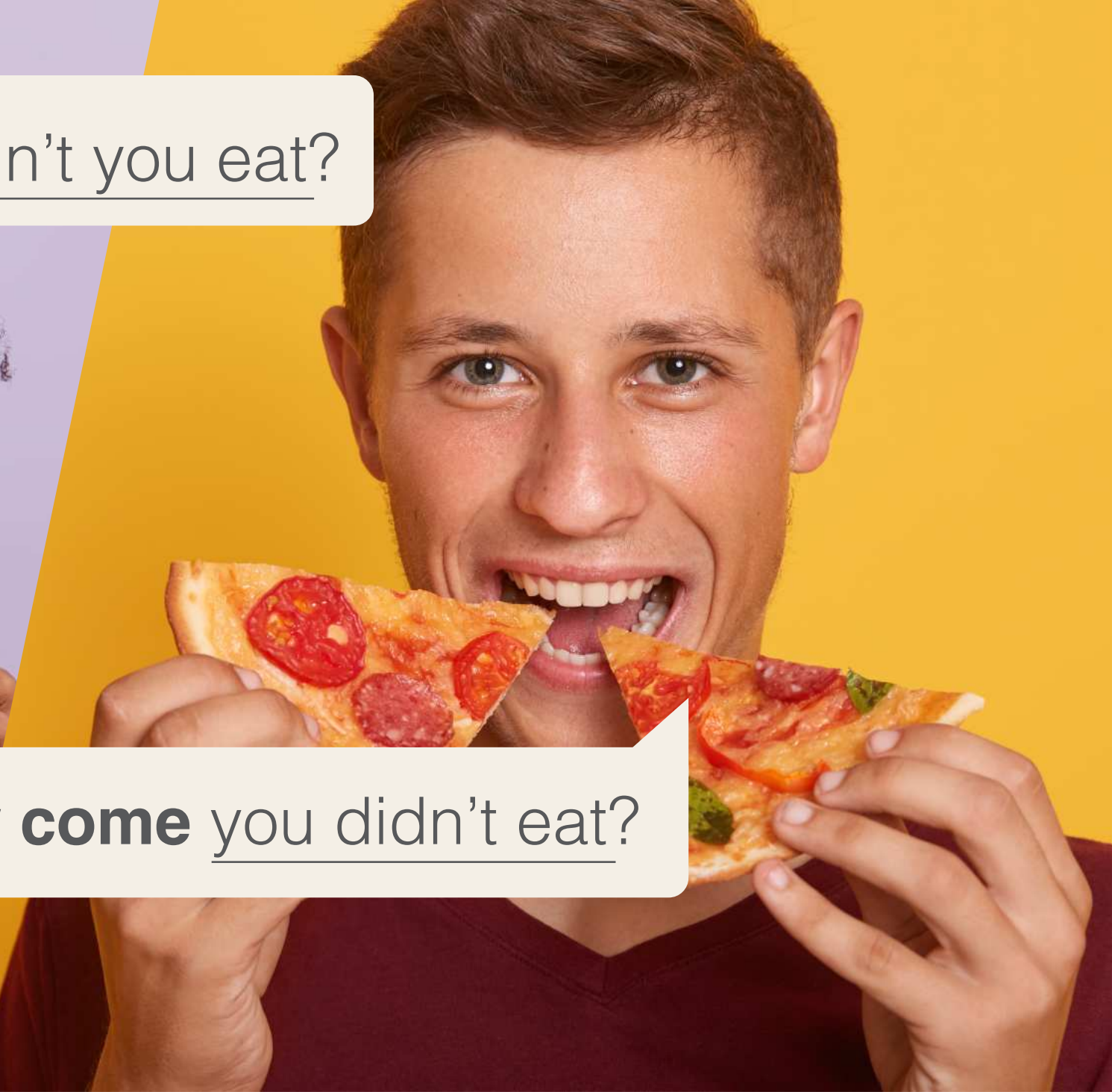
Why is she here?

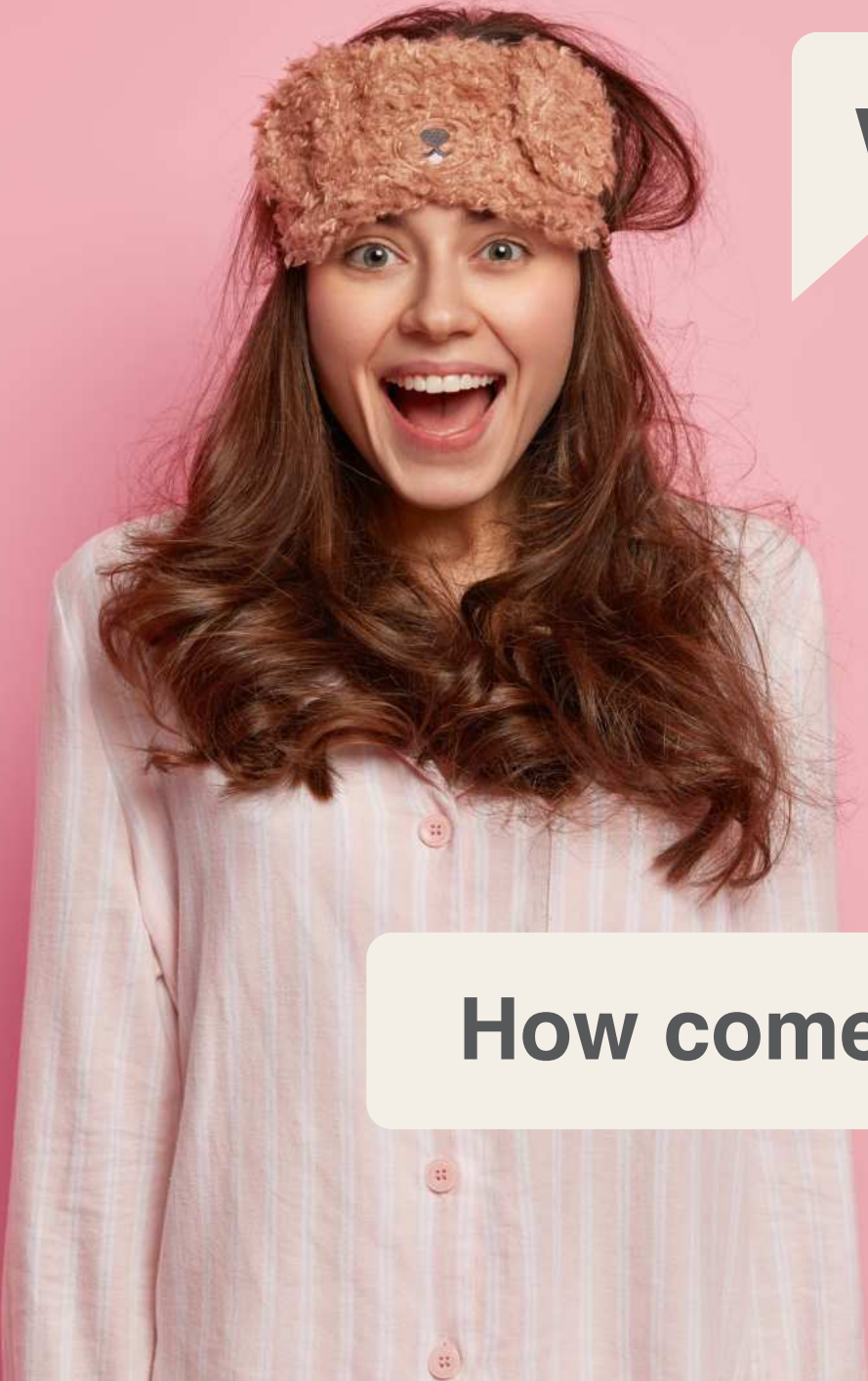
How come you didn't eat?
